An Arts Centre for Ealing

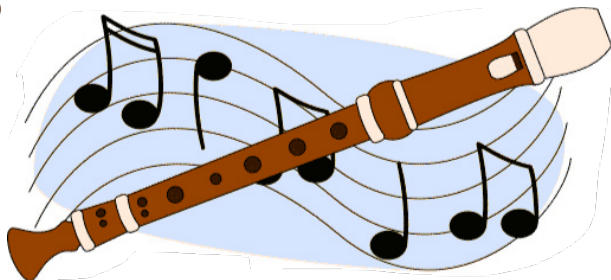
We want Ealing to be a regional centre of excellence for music, drama, dance, film, comedy and other arts.

We need a multi-purpose performance and community space with modern facilities to complement existing cultural, educational and cinema provision.

Why?

Our Demand Survey showed that:

- a high proportion of local people think that arts and cultural activities are important to the community
- central Ealing is poorly served with facilities for performance arts
- better provision would bring back to Ealing local people who now go elsewhere for shopping and entertainment.



How can we afford it?

From April 2017 all large new developments in the town centre have to pay £100 per square metre Community Infrastructure Levy. At least 25% of this must be spent on facilities agreed with the local community.

Because of the scale of development that will transform Ealing over the next few years, this Levy could create a £multi-million fund.

That fund can help make a performance and arts centre happen.
